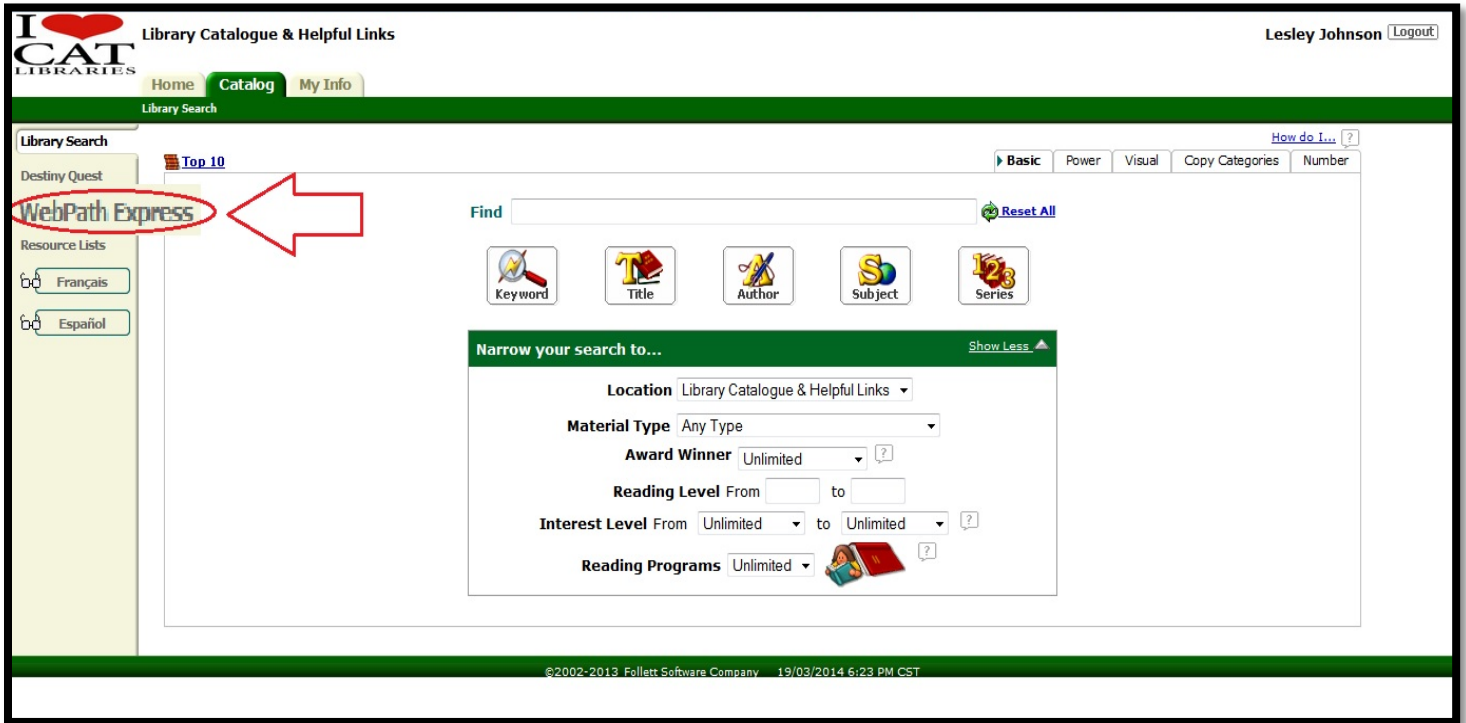

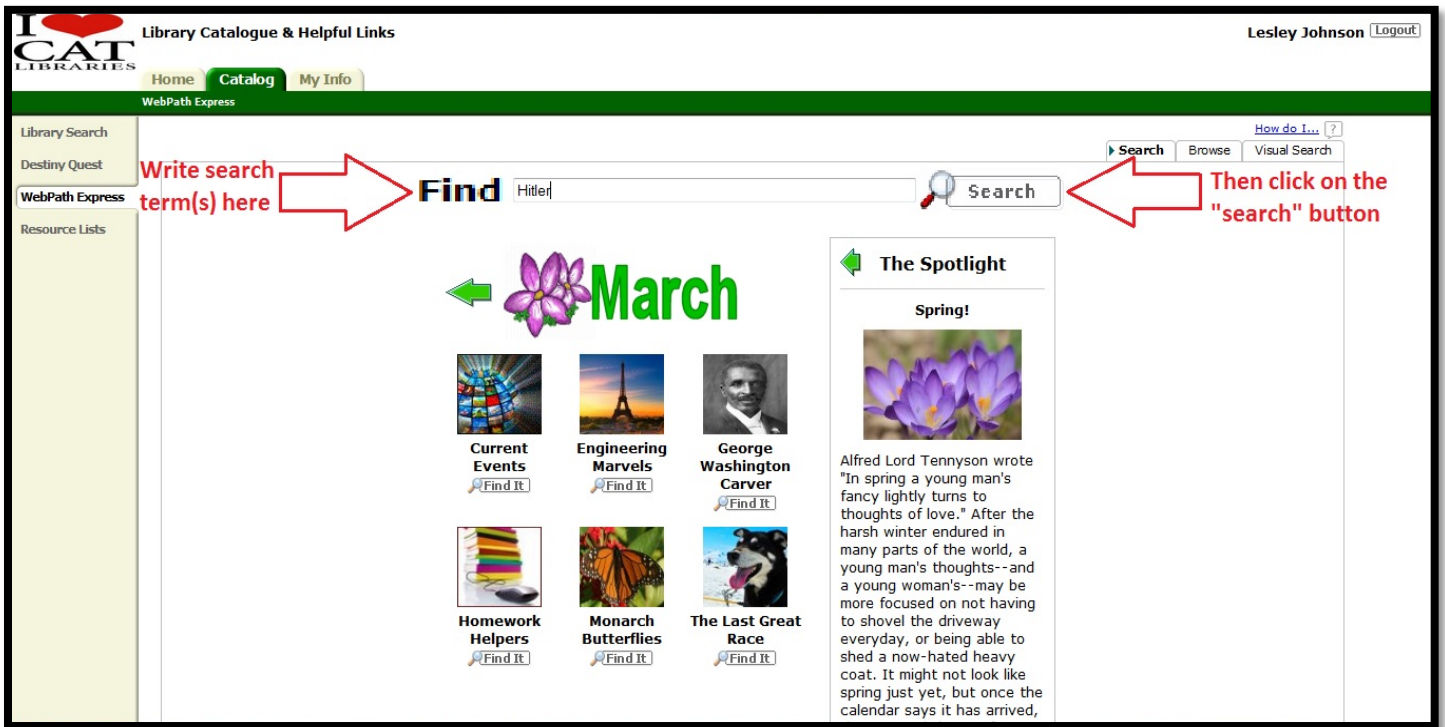

If you know your lexile level, you can search for resources within your level by choosing from the "Lexile" drop-down menu.

However, if you further need to refine your results, you can use words like "AND," "OR," and "NOT." Click on "Refine your search?" and try a new search.

Additional Search Word	What it does	Example	Example Results
AND	<u>Narrows</u> your search by finding both terms in the resource.	cowboys AND rodeos	You will find only articles that contain the words cowboys and rodeos.
OR	<u>Broadens</u> your search by finding resources that include either term in the resource.	cowboys OR cowhand	You will find resources that contain the words cowboys or cowhand, the gender inclusive term for cowboy.
NOT or AND NOT	<u>Narrows</u> your search so it does not include the second term.	cowboys NOT football	You will find resources that do not contain anything about football (or the Dallas Cowboys).
